**Subject: Minimum Number of Credits Required for Awarding a Degree**

The total number of credits required to earn a degree will be calculated based on an average of **twenty-two (22) credits per regular semester**, with an allowable margin of **+2.5%**. For example, a 4-year degree program comprising eight semesters would require **22 x 8 = 176 credits**. Therefore, the credits to be earned for any program will range between **176 and 180**.

However, the minimum number of credits a candidate shall earn is as prescribed for the specific program and batch within this range. For instance, if a program specifies **178 credits** for a particular batch, all students from that batch must earn a minimum of **178 credits** to qualify for the degree of that program, along with fulfilling other conditions outlined in the **Regulations Governing UG and PG Programs 2015**.
