Subject: Minimum Number of Credits Required for Awarding a Degree

The total number of credits required to earn a degree will be calculated based on an average of twenty-two (22) credits per regular semester, with an allowable margin of +2.5%. For example, a 4-year degree program comprising eight semesters would require $22 \times 8 = 176$ credits. Therefore, the credits to be earned for any program will range between 176 and 180.

However, the minimum number of credits a candidate shall earn is as prescribed for the specific program and batch within this range. For instance, if a program specifies 178 credits for a particular batch, all students from that batch must earn a minimum of 178 credits to qualify for the degree of that program, along with fulfilling other conditions outlined in the Regulations Governing UG and PG Programs 2015.
